Project «The Blue Treasure of Earth»



They studied states of water, natural water cycles, life of aquatic plants and animals. At the basic level children started to understand the water system on our planet, its fragility and vulnerability to human influence.









Aim: to make children understand the value of the Earth's water resources and the right of every man to equal access to clear drinking water.

The project involved children of 3 to 7 years old, pedagogues and parents. Children from 3 to 5 learned about properties of water, meaning of water for plants, animals and people, about different types of water bodies. Children from 5 to 7 learned about water as habitat for plants, animals and humans.



We tried to make children not only listeners, but active participants of all the events. We started discussions and experiments, went on excursions, carried out research, organized ecological celebrations and holidays. We taught children analysis and discourse.



We also created a minimuseum of water, drew pictures of water and its inhabitants, and made posters

in defense of those who don't have access to clean water.













The project is closely connected to the other OMEP Project - «WASH from the START»

Children started to understand importance of water for our planet, dependence of water system on each person's actions. But the main thing they've understood is that each person on our planet has the right to sufficient clean water.
